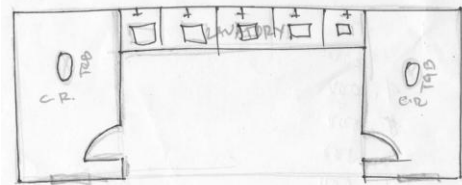
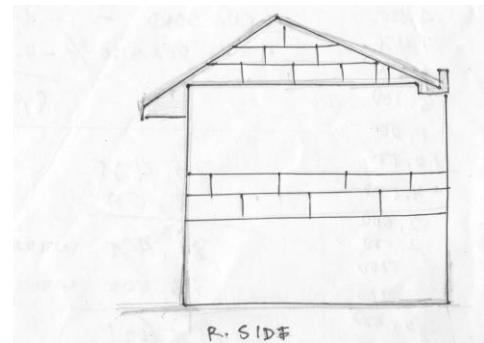
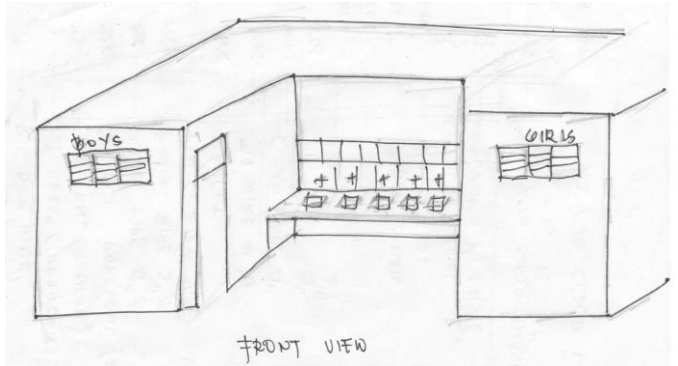


All the teachers of EBI praying over the six graduates
