I am sorry to report that **PAMI was hit hard by Typhoon Glenda** on July 15. Thankfully no PAMI people were hurt, but there's much damage. Our Bible school campus was hit the hardest (see photos below), but other PAMI churches and homes also need repairs. It is estimated that it will take about \$2000 to complete repairs at Emmaus Bible Institute, and probably another \$1000-2000 to help other PAMI churches and church members. There is no insurance to help with this unforeseen extra expense, so we could really use extra gifts. I think of how 1Cor12:25-26 says to the church body that "...its parts should have equal concern for each other. If one part suffers, every part suffers with it..." After learning about your Philippine brothers and sisters in need, I hope you will consider praying for or helping financially with recovery efforts.
