MINISTRY HIGHLIGHTS

Since the last newsletters (*Nov 2013 PAMI News* and *Jan 2014 PAMI Bulletin*), highlights include distribution of about a thousand Samaritan's Purse Operation Christmas Child boxes, the first all-PAMI youth camp, the start of monthly Family Development Sessions, delivery of a 3rd and 4th batch of typhoon relief, plus Bible school graduation, summer vacation activities like VBS and workshops, and the start of the new school year. In addition, our 15 churches/church plants continue to grow, with prospects for more daughter chapels being considered. There are on-going Bible study outreaches, children's feeding outreaches, film showings, radio programs, weekly Compassion kids sessions, etc. The following pictures/captions give more details, to prompt you to praise God, pray, and partner with us. Future plans are in the works for group baptisms and a big Emmaus Bible Institute alumni reunion.



Sad to see demolition of half the former bakery building (living quarters of Ptr Rafael's family) and the front wall of EBI due to road widening. Since the government refuses to compensate, it's costing us \$1000 to replace the front wall, and another \$1000 to add a room to the back side of Ptr Raf's house.



Five graduated from Emmaus Bible Institute on March 20, with ceremony theme of "living with a purpose" (Prov 19:21). EBI students returned from summer vacation on June 9 and classes resumed June 16. There are now 8 new freshmen, and 25 students in all, with 6 seniors doing internships.



After 3 years, praise God PAMI once again qualified to distribute OCC boxes: 550 through EBI and its outreaches at the end of March, and a few

hundred more through other PAMI churches. In addition to boxes, Samaritan's Purse provides training and materials for teaching. Before giving the gifts, several days are spent teaching kids things from the Bible and leading them in receiving Jesus Christ in their lives. We also invite them to attend Sunday Service and follow-up with other outreach ministry. Parents become more open to the Gospel too.



Almost 110 youth (ages 12-24) and 40 staff/staff family gathered for the first all-PAMI evangelistic and discipleship camp with theme "Great Commission in Action" (Matt 28:19). Youth from 10 churches stayed at Andy's Point resort from April 7-11, listening to staff speak on topics of evangelism, discipleship, prayer, values, and love, courtship, and marriage. They also had morning devotions, exercises, games, talent night, bonfire, and singing. A youth from Bulan said, "I feel so blessed and there's a joy inside me after that & until now--not only me, but all those who attended. Thanks."

This page is meant to summarize a portion of PAMI, so you can better appreciate the amazing amount of ministry done by the Filipino nationals. Although PAMI has four partitions, let's just consider the EBI partition. Besides serving as a Bible school, the EBI campus also serves as a Compassion Int'l center where 150 sponsored kids come for 6 hours each Saturday from 8 am to 2 pm, and houses a Compassion office and several Compassion staff. Furthermore, EBI is home to Emmaus Christian Fellowship, a church that serves the neighboring community and has many cell group/ Bible study/ children's ministry outreaches nearby, including daughter chapels in Penafrancia and Bulubog. The two tables to the left, provided by our EBI director, Sister Ofel Mendizabal, help give a nice overview of these outreaches. Pastors, teachers, Compassion staff, and some students keep a busy schedule by juggling many outreach times with their other duties.

In addition to regular outreaches, monthly FDS is a new avenue begun in April. FDS is part of iHELP(international/intentional/incarnational/indigenous Holistic Engagement for Life and Progress) arm of the Philippine Council of Evangelical Churches. FDS is done in conjunction with the Dept. of Social Welfare & Development 4P's (Pantawid Pamilyang Pilipino Program) to help the poorest of the poor. Different from how the U.S. likes to separate church and state, the Philippine government enlists church volunteers to teach values formation and responsible parenthood from a Biblical basis, to go along with the DSWD cash transfer.

The table to the left shows how EBI is helping facilitate FDS in a total of 8 nearby barangays (villages/neighborhoods).

Ptr Lorenzo is also doing FDS in Bulusan. Note that Lorenz was recently transferred from EBI to Bulusan church. He has a big heart for Bulusan, since it's his hometown. He's also doing film showings there.

Ptra Lordy has also been doing FDS in San Isidro, Samar. She says, "In the month of February I teach FDS for the 4P's parents, together with my intern student Ferkay, about how to have a strong relationship inside the family and we also shared to them the word of God which is the most important thing. We conduct FDS in 12 barangays here in San Isidro...I thank God because through this program I met a lot of people."

Other PAMI pastors may also do FDS.
